## HARVESTING THE JUNIPER FRUIT (Juniperus macrocarpa)



Maritime juniper (Juniperus macrocarpa)
Its habitat is sandy soils and dunes.
This species is <u>protected</u> in Andalusia.

The leaves differ from Juniperus turbinata by being triverticillate, acicular and rigid with a pointed apex. It has two white stripes on the upper surface, separated by a narrower green vein.

The harvesting of the berries is carried out in Autumn / Winter and the technique is sliding the hand from inside the bush outwards, taking the berries with it.
