

CONSERVACIÓN DUNAR - African daisy (*Arctotheca calendula*) - Invasive species



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The construction of the pedestrian boardwalks in this dune area has resulted in damage to the sandy soil and has favoured the explosive propagation of the plant listed by the Ministry of Environment as **invasive**. There is a risk of altering intact areas.

In principle the plants are spread by seeds, which can cause a large quantity of regrowth from rhizomes or tubers. Dispersion is mainly anemochorous (by the wind) and also zoochorous (by animals).
