

18.10.2022

We started today by going to the beach. We admired the landscape of Elviria Beach.

Upon reaching the dunes, we were greeted by the head of ProDunas - Mrs. Susanne. We received assignments. Initially, we watered young trees. They were fenced with a net.

During the watering, we were presented with junipers called Juniperus.

We are presented with weeds that disrupt the local ecosystem. After collecting them to the appropriate silos, we moved the weeds to a composting plant.

The boss from ProDunas introduced us to the local plants. We found out that there are many species of plants. Among them was Juniperus macrocarpa.

Juniperus macrocarpa is a juniper native to the northern region that grows on coastal dunes from sea level. It is a sprawling shrub.

Our task was to collect the ripe fruits of this shrub. The fruit is purple and the unripe green. They grow in large clusters arranged on branches. They are packed in small containers and shipped elsewhere in a neighboring town. The seeds then return to the dunes for the next teapot to grow.



25.10. 2022

We started with getting to know today's tasks presented to us by a volunteer from ProDunas.

We got our work tool - a robot. We cut willows with them and put them in baskets.

When we were done, the next task was to collect the weeds and grass from the small junipers and flowers



2.11.2022

In the morning we set off for Dunas de Artola.

The task was to cut out the harmful plant. This plant is called Lantana camara. It is included in the list of the most harmful plant species. It is a fast-growing and green shrub.

Flowering lasts from spring until the first cold weather. It spreads quickly. Removing it is difficult. It is resistant to fire. After eating this plant, animals get sick and is very harmful to them. But for butterflies it is a good food.



8.11.2022

We came to Elviria Beach with volunteers. We had to trim plants that were obstructing the walkway to the beach. Among them was the oleander of Nerium. Oleander is a plant with multi-colored and beautifully fragrant flowers. It is a tropical plant, it grows in places where there is the most sun, it needs to be trimmed often to maintain the aesthetics and not to disturb the vegetation on the dunes.
